Shotgun Basics Clinics and Sporting Clays Clinics – 2021 Schedule

All dates are tentative pending Covid19 situation.

Open to Members and the Public – ASC offers two types of clinics for beginners and experienced shotgun shooters. Learn how to mount and swing a shotgun and how to set up for a successful break. Practice with Certified Wingshooting Instructors to help develop your skills. Some shotgun experience helpful but not required. Participants under 18 years old must be mature enough to pay attention and follow safety rules and strong enough to safely hold and swing a 7-8 pound shotgun. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or grandparent. Preregistration is required. No walk-ins please. **Plan to bring a face covering until further notice.**

- ❖ ASC Members: Classes are free. Practice rounds are five dollars (\$5) for every 25 targets.
- ❖ Nonmembers: There is a thirty-dollar (\$30) fee for instruction and practice targets.

Participants bring: Traditional hunting or sporting shotgun in 12, 16, or 20 gauge with Improved Cylinder or Modified chokes. Also: two or three boxes of target load lead or steel 7 ½ or 8 shot factory ammunition, safety glasses and hearing protection. Loaner auto-loading shotguns in 12 or 20 gauge, adult or youth models, can be requested when you pre-register. Cash or checks only please. FOID cards are not required to attend the class, but please know how the Illinois laws apply to you for transport and possession of firearms and ammunition.

Shotgun Basics Clinic: Covers shotgun information and use, safety, clay target shooting and common games. Classroom time is followed by on-field instruction. Preregistration required by email to SpecialPrograms@Aurorasc.org. Meet in the club office area on 7858 Preserve Road, Waterman IL ten minutes before class starts to sign in on the class dates listed below. Class takes approximately three hours.

Intro to Sporting Clays Clinic: Field work only (no classroom) on the Sporting Clays Course. Learn how to read and set up to break a variety of clay target presentations. Preregistration is required by email to SpecialPrograms@Aurorasc.org. Each session meets at the Sporting Clays range ten minutes before class start time and lasts two-three hours.
