Come join the fun and test your shooting skills with your friends and family with the all-new All Clays League! Teams of 5 shooters will compete by shooting three rounds of trap, skeet, 5 stand, pyramid wobble, and springing teal over a 12-week season.

Teams may shoot at any time allowed by club rules and either during staffed hours or unstaffed hours. Events shot during staffed hours will be scored by an ASC puller. Teams may self-score for events shot during off hours with the team Captain responsible for certifying scores. **SCORING WILL BE ON THE HONOR SYSTEM – NO CHEATING!**

The league is open to both members and non-members, but the team captain must be an ASC member.

Teams may shoot at any time and in any order but must complete all 5 events starting April 17, 2021 and finishing by July 18, 2021.

To register a team, please have the team captain complete the Excel registration form with your team captain's name, as well as the name of each team member and their email address and cell number. Save the Excel file as your team's name and email a copy to [allclaysleague@aurorasc.org](mailto:allclaysleague@aurorasc.org).

If you are an individual looking to shoot but do not have a team please email [allclaysleague@aurorasc.org](mailto:allclaysleague@aurorasc.org) with your name, cell number and email address and we will do our best to place you on a team.

The league will start on April 17, 2021 and will run until July 18, 2021.

Cost for the league will be \$35 per member as a league fee. Team members will pay the regular price for rounds shot, which are as follows:

Discounted game cards for eleven (11) shotgun games will be for sale, cash or check, from on-duty staff during open-to-the-public weekends and special events. Cards are available for members and nonmembers and are valid for one year.

### Rules for the League.

1. Schedule: The league will shoot at any time allowed by club rules between April 17, 2021 and July 18, 2021. Rounds shot after this date will not be included in the final score.
2. Team Competition - each team member will shoot:
  - a. Three rounds (25 targets) of trap singles from the 16-yard line.
  - b. Three rounds of skeet (25 targets).
  - c. Three rounds of 5-stand using the basic/beginner menu (25 targets).
  - d. Three rounds of Pyramid wobble (25 targets).
  - e. Three rounds of Springing Teal (25 targets).
3. Rounds may be shot anytime during regular club shooting hours.
  - a. Rounds shot during staffed hours will be scored by an ASC puller.
  - b. Rounds shot outside of staffed hours will be self-scored but certified by the team captain.
  - c. Team captains are expected to verify all scores and certify score sheets before they are submitted.
4. Scoresheets: Completed scoresheets should be emailed to [allclaysleague@aurorasc.org](mailto:allclaysleague@aurorasc.org) as soon as possible upon completion of the round. Be sure to include your team name on the score sheet. Scoresheets must be signed or certified by the team captain. A scanned copy or photograph of the scoresheet is acceptable, provided it is legible.
5. Qualification: Teams must have completed three rounds of all 5 events to qualify for league prizes.
6. Target Previews: The squad leader may request to see one target from each launcher prior to the start of each round.
7. A target which breaks at launching or fails to launch shall be called NO BIRD and shooter will be provided a new target. All other targets launched but not shot at must be counted as misses.
8. The league fee will be \$35. Individuals will pay the regular price for their rounds as they shoot them.
9. A final event and awards presentation will be held at the All-Clays Event in October. Prizes will be awarded for best team scores, best individual scores, as well as other prizes and random drawings.
10. League participation requirements – The league is open to all full members and guests. However, Team Captains must be ASC members and must have received training in the proper operation of clay launching equipment to be able to shoot during unstaffed hours.
11. League management reserves the right to disqualify anyone for unruly or unsafe behavior.
12. This is a fun league and is operated on the honor system. Please be honest with your scoring.
